

How to...

**Register to use the Student Site Tools** (any insured member)

1. Register at the online registration page:  
<https://members.geobluestudents.com/Registration/Member>
2. Enter Certificate number, Date of Birth, First and Last name and click submit
3. Follow online instructions
4. You can also register through the GeoBlue app. Download it from the [Apple App Store](#), [Google Play Store](#) or [Amazon App Store](#) and then select Register from the home screen.

**Print an ID Card**

1. Click on 'ID Card' in the right hand column of the enrollment transaction table
2. Click on 'ID Card' *Note:* ID Card is a .pdf file, requiring the free Adobe Acrobat Reader.
